They do have locations in **Falls Church, VA** and **Alexandria, VA**. They don't require an appointment and will take a rapid test (result in 15 minutes) and a PCR (24-48h) test at the same time.

- Upcounty Regional Services Center. 12900 Middlebrook Road, Germantown. Open seven days weekly, 9 a.m.-6 p.m.
