GENERAL INFORMATION:

The School Nurse is responsible for all health related care of students and staff. This position interacts with students, faculty, staff, and parents. The ideal candidate will be available for a full-time position. Although, two part-time candidates may also be considered.

DESCRIPTION:

Duties and responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Providing direct health care to students and staff
- Providing acute care and first aid to students and staff in the case of injuries or acute illness
- Treatment, monitoring and follow up of acute and chronic health problems, including administration of medications according to physician's orders
- Communicating with parents and care-givers regarding chronic treatment or clinical follow up issues
- Management of emergencies (911) and referral to other providers if necessary
- Maintaining and updating medical records for each student and utilizing a computerized record system (Magnus)
- Assure that immunization records and health inventory forms, as required by law, are properly updated each year
- Revise as needed, all health forms used by the school, and draft any health related communication to students, faculty and parents
- Provide leadership for compliance in vaccination requirements
- Screening, referral and follow up for specific health conditions:
 - Screening may include parasites, vision, scoliosis and other screening as necessary or prescribed by law
 - Provide leadership for the provision of (public) health services
 - Assess and benchmark the overall system of school health services and make
