

Thank you for your interest in the **German International School Washington D.C.** Provided below is a checklist of the items needed for your child's application to be considered for admission.

Middle School (Grades 5-9) and High School (Grades 10-11) Admissions Checklist

Admissions for the Middle and High school are competitive, and the application process includes a comprehensive review of the applicant's academic performance and potential. Please follow the steps below via our Blackbaud Applicant Portal (coming soon) to complete the admissions process:

1. Application Form (required for all applicants)

- Complete the application for Grades 5-11 by creating an account via the Blackbaud Applicant Portal. (coming soon)
- Pay non-refundable \$100 application fee via the Blackboud Applicant Portal. (coming soon)
- Birth Certificate (required for all applicants) & Visa (if applicable, due before first day of school)
 - □ Upload a copy of the student's birth certificate for age verification.
 - Upload a copy of a valid visa (for international students) via the Blackbaud Applicant Portal
- 3. Health Form for Application (required for all Applicants)
 - □ Submit the Parent Health Form (no doctor's appointment required) with application, available as download via the Blackbaud Applicant Portal.
- 4. Emergency Contact & Medical Forms (required for all applicants, due before the first day of school)
 - Complete medical and emergency contact information forms after acceptance to GISW via **Magnus Health**. You will receive an invitation to join Magnus, our health portal for medical documents, from service@magnushealhportal.com.
 - Provide up-to-date immunization records after acceptance to GISW via Magnus Health.
 - Submit physical examination records (typically within the last 12 months) after acceptance to GISW via Magnus Health.
- 5. Student Transcript/Report Cards (required for all Applicants)
 - Provide and download transcripts or report cards for the last 4 years (Grades 5-9) or last 5 years (Grades 10-11) via the Blackbaud Applicant Portal. Please note: Grade 12 enrollment is not possible.
- 6. Teacher/School Recommendations (required for all Applicants)
 - Request and submit 1-2 Recommendation Form(s) from current teachers or school administrators who can speak to your student's academic performance and character via the Blackbaud Applicant Portal. At least one recommendation should be from a core academic subject teacher. Request and submit English and Math Recommendation Forms via the Blackbaud Applicant Portal from your child's current subject teachers.
- 7. Student (Language) Assessment for FastTrack or Non-German-Speaking Parent (if applicable)
 - GISW requires students to take an **English and Math entrance exam** (either in person or virtually) if applying for the <u>FastTrack program</u> (only Grade 5), and or a language assessment (Grades 5-9) when at least one parent is non-German-speaking. You will receive an invitation from the Admissions Office.

8. Parent/Student Interview & Tour (optional)

- Meet with the Admissions Office to discuss the child's needs, family's educational philosophy, and overall school fit. Book the meeting via the Blackbaud Applicant Portal.
- Book a campus tour via the Blackbaud Applicant Portal.
- 9. Check Application Status
 - □ Parents may check their child's admissions status online by visiting the Blackbaud Applicant Portal. If you have questions about the admission application process, please contact us at <u>admissions@giswashington.org</u>.
- 10. Tuition Assistance Program (Financial Aid) (if applicable)
 - □ If applying for financial aid, submit the **Financial Aid for School Tuition (FAST)** form by February 15. You may find more information on <u>the tuition page</u> on the GISW website.
- 11. Non-Refundable Enrollment Fee (required for all students) & Contract Deposit (if applicable)
 - □ GISW charges a \$2000 non-refundable enrollment fee upon acceptance.
 - □ Families will receive a contract with a \$1000 deposit fee. The Tuition will be prorated for families who join after the start of the year.
