Preschool Admissions Checklist

For GISW Preschool admissions for children age 2-4, the process focuses on ensuring that students are developmentally ready for a preschool environment. Please follow the steps below via our Blackbaud Applicant Portal (coming soon) to complete the admissions process:

		Complete the school's application for Preschool by creating an account via the Blackbaud Applicant Portal
		(coming soon).
		Pay non-refundable \$100 application fee via the Blackbaud Applicant Portal.
2.	Birth Cer	rtificate (required for all applicants) & Visa (if applicable)
		Upload a copy of the child's birth certificate for age verification. GISW requires children to be at least 2 years
		old for the 2-year-old program and at least 3 years old for the 3 and 4year-old program.
		Upload a valid US visa for international students. (Due before first day of school)

		Submit Parent Health Form (no doctor's appointment required) with application, available as download
		through the Blackbaud Applicant Portal.
4.	Emergen	cy Contact & other Medical Forms (required for all applicants) Due before first day of School.
		Complete medical and emergency contact information forms after acceptance to GISW via Magnus Health.
		You will receive an invitation to join Magnus, our health portal for medical documents, from
		service@magnushealhportal.com.
		Provide up-to-date immunization records after acceptance to GISW via Magnus Health.
		Submit physical examination records (typically from within the last 12 months) after acceptance to GISW via
		Magnus Health.

		Request and submit a reference from any previous/current preschool, daycare, or caregiver if applicable.
		Reference Form will be available through the Blackbaud Applicant Portal.

	Ш	Attend an interview with the Admissions Team or Director of Preschool, where staff will ask about your child's
		personality, home environment, and developmental history. Schedule the (in-person/virtual) interview
_		through the Admissions Portal.
7.	_	Visit (required for all applicants) & Parent Tour (optional)
	Ш	GISW requires a short visit where the child plays and interacts with staff to assess social and emotional
		readiness. Student Visit will be scheduled through the Admissions Office after receiving the Application.
•		Parents will also have the opportunity to tour the Preschool facilities during this time.

10.		GISW charges a \$2000 non-refundable enrollment fee upon acceptance.
		Families will receive a contract for electronic signature via the Blackbaud Parent Portal with a \$1000 deposit
		fee due at signing. The contract deposit fee is deducted from tuition fees on your final bill. Tuition fees are
		prorated for mid-year enrollments.
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
