**REQUIREMENTS:**

- Meets all requirements to be certified as an early childhood educator under the regulations of the Office of Child Care (OCC)
- Degree in Early Childhood Education or an associate's degree in Early Childhood Education or a related field
- At least one year of professional experience in a licensed kindergarten or preschool
- All instruction is conducted in German. Excellent written and spoken German skills are therefore expected, and good English language skills are also required
- Flexibility and the willingness to work independently
- A team-oriented approach with strong communication skills to collaborate effectively with colleagues, parents, and children
